You will need to source your own alpaca wool to add variety to the class.

- Class 3 A Hat featuring 3 or more colours
- Class 4 A Headband featuring a pattern
- Class 5 A Pair of Gloves or Mittens with a contrasting cuff
- Class 6 A Pair of Fingerless Gloves
- Class 7 A Pair of Socks
- Class 8 A Scarf with a Decorative Trim (i.e beads or tassels)
- Class 9 A Wrap more than 30cm wide
- Class 10 An Infinity Cowl
- Class 11 Any Other Wearable Item
